### ADDITIONAL RULES OF ENTRY

- Youth eligible to exhibit in this department are those enrolled in a 4H, FFA, or other approved youth group carrying a similar supervised program in a Poultry project area.
- Only one entry may be entered under each lot number.
- Poultry exhibited in the Junior Fair Show may not be shown in Open Class.
- Exhibit birds must be in the possession of the exhibitor by June 1 except market broilers.

### REQUIREMENTS, REGULATIONS & RULES:

A complete list of animal exhibit rules can be found in the '**General Rules for Junior Division Exhibitors**' section of the premium book. All rules within that section of the premium book apply, in addition to the information documented herein.

#### **Animal Identification:**

- Numbered leg bands are given at Pullorum Testing.

#### **Required Records or Documents:**

- Exhibitors must turn in record keeping documents from their project to the department Superintendent at check-in.
  - 4-H Project Record Book pages or FFA SAE Award Application qualifies.
    - Other record forms need to be submitted to the Fair Board in advance of the Fair for approval.
  - 'Youth Livestock Project Record' form (choose the correct grade) for Market Poultry only.
  - Pullorum test reports and/or hatchery certificates/receipts.
    - Please see 'Animal Health' for testing and report requirements.
  - 'Livestock Managerial Project Agreement' form if the animal is not owned by the exhibitor.
- All records must be signed and fully completed, NO EXCEPTIONS!

#### **Animal Health:**

- All health requirements set by the State of Wisconsin DATCP must be met before the animals are allowed entry at the Fair.
- Testing Requirements:
  - All birds entered over 4 months of age must have a copy of their Pullorum test report.
  - All birds entered under 4 months of age must have a copy of their hatchery certificate/receipt.
  - Any egg entries must have a copy of the Pullorum test report for their entire flock.
    - The testing of the exhibitor's entire flock for egg entries is done at the expense of the exhibitor.
- All testing reports must be turned in to the Superintendent before birds are brought into the barn.
- Turkey Entries:
  - The whole blood rapid plate test is no longer acceptable for turkeys.
  - The Oconto County Fair only requires Pullorum testing for turkeys. If exhibitors are members of the NPIP Plan, they would need to additionally have their exhibits tested for MG.

- If further clarification on testing requirements is needed, contact the Superintendents.
- Birds infested with external parasites should be treated early enough that residue of insecticidal dust is not present on the birds when brought to the fair. Birds rejected at check-in for external parasites may not be brought back for check-in after being treated for parasites.

#### **Pen Reservations:**

- Exhibitors must contact Fair Data Entry Clerk: Stacie Pienta *no later* than August 3 to reserve the number of pens they will require.

- Exhibitors must specify the number of cages needed for geese, turkeys, ducks, pigeons, chickens, or bantams, so required cage sizes can be planned for.
- Exhibitors should indicate what exhibits can be doubled up if there is a shortage of cages.

#### **Barn rules and displays:**

A complete list of barn and display rules can be found in the ‘**General Rules for Junior Division Exhibitors**’ section of the premium book.

- Each exhibitor must bring suitable containers for feed and water and must supply their own fasteners for cages.
- All exhibitors are responsible for feeding and watering their own animals and all animals must have food and water in their cage until dismissal.
- Pens should be cleaned on a daily basis.
- All pens must be cleaned before birds will be released.

#### **Additional Rules for Exhibits:**

- Entries in "any other" breed classes cannot be birds for which regular classes have been listed.
- Poultry entered in the market class may not be shown in any other class.
- In accordance with WDATCP ATCP 160, classes may be combined where there is no competition, or split if too large.
- Weigh-In: Birds will be weighed upon entry (if applicable).

### **AWARDS - ELIGIBILITY, REQUIREMENTS AND PROCEDURES**

#### **Sale of Champions**

Youth exhibiting in any market poultry class can qualify for the Sale of Champions if all requirements are met.

- Exhibitors must meet all requirements outlined in ‘**General Rules for Junior Division Exhibitors**’ section of the premium book.
- Exhibitors must have shown poultry in at least one class in addition to the market class in the poultry show at the Oconto County Fair.
- Exhibits must meet performance standards.
- Market Poultry Exhibitors awarded the Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion of the Fryer Chicken, Roaster Chicken, Broiler Chicken, Market Duck, Market Turkey and Market Goose entries in poultry show will sell in the Sale of Champions, if qualified.
- Exhibit birds must be in the possession of the exhibitor by June 1 except market broilers.
- To reduce time required and confusion, birds will be weighed upon entry rather than on show day.

**REQUIREMENTS:**

- New State of Wisconsin DATCP requirements: To exhibit eggs, the exhibitor's whole flock must be tested and must be negative for pullorum. Per the Fair Board, testing of the exhibitor's whole flock is done at the expense of the exhibitor.
- Exhibits are 6 eggs displayed in half an egg carton
- Classes 1 through 3 must be standard large eggs
- Colored eggs must be naturally colored blue, green, or pink

### **REQUIREMENTS:**

- Exhibitors in poultry showmanship must show one of their project animals in the showmanship class.
- This class will use the Danish Judging system.
- To shorten the length of the show, poultry showmanship will be judged throughout the day by a second judge.
- Exhibitors must check in with showmanship judges to do showmanship whenever they have a break in showing in their exhibits.
