
Superintendents:

### ADDITIONAL RULES OF ENTRY

- Youth eligible to exhibit in this department are those enrolled in a 4-H Cloverbuds project or other youth group carrying a similar program as their supervised project.
- All exhibits must be the result of this year's project by the exhibitor.
- Only one exhibit may be entered under each lot number.

### REQUIREMENTS:

- Entries must be made by the youth exhibitor (with adult or youth leader supervision). Each exhibitor should be able to explain their project entry to the face-to-face judge
- Cloverbuds are limited to three (3) entries
- A participation ribbon, a premium of \$1.50, and a coupon for an ice cream treat from the 4-H Food Stand will be awarded to each Cloverbud exhibitor
- Posters must be 14" X 22"
- No live animals may be exhibited in the Cloverbud department
- **Food exhibits/entries:**
  - Exhibit plates will be provided
  - Food exhibits are not returned to the exhibitor

### CLASS A – CLOVERBUDS

#### **Lot Numbers:**

1. Favorite craft item: ceramics, leather craft, stitchery, stenciling, woodworking, etc.
2. Poster or display about 4-H
3. Poster or display about a hobby you enjoy
4. Simple food item: (3) cookies, brownies, cupcakes, etc.
5. Nature collection or display: insects, rocks, leaves, etc.
6. Garden exhibit: (3) vegetables of one type grown in your garden
7. Plant exhibit: (4) cut flowers, a potted plant, terrarium, or dish garden
8. Homemade Holiday item
9. Poster or display about your pet
10. Any other Cloverbud exhibit not listed above
