- Exhibits may not have previously been exhibited at Oconto County Fair.
- Exhibits must have been created since the last fair.

CLASS A – DECORATIVE ITEMS FOR THE HOME

NOTE: Holiday or seasonal themed items must be entered in 'Class B: Holiday or Seasonal Items for the Home' if a duplicate lot description is available.

- **Throw:** Approximate size of 50" x 65"
- **Bed Quilt, Small:** Approximate size of 72" x 90"
- **Bed Quilt, Large:** Approximate size of 85" x 108" or larger
