ADDITIONAL RULES OF ENTRY

- Exhibitors in this Department must be aged 5-19 as of January 1st of the fair year.
- Exhibitors in this Department must be an Oconto County Resident.
- All exhibits must have been created by the exhibitor.
- Only one exhibit may be entered under each lot number.
- Exhibits may not have previously been exhibited at Oconto County Fair.
- Exhibits must have been created since the last fair.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Exhibits may be made with either hand or power tools and must be finished and ready to use
- A 3" x 5" index card must accompany each entry, describing the article, its intended use, the method used in making the project, and any other information that would help in judging
- Projects will be judged on woodworking skills, materials and finish appropriate to its use and if the project is ready to use
- **Kits:**
 - A 'kit' is a project where the exhibitor purchased a design and materials in pre-packaged form and assembled the pieces into a project
 - Kits are **not** allowed in this Department
 - Exception: Class A, Lot 1: Item made from a kit
