### ADDITIONAL RULES OF ENTRY

- Youth eligible to exhibit in this department are those enrolled in a 4H, FFA, or other approved youth group carrying a similar supervised program in a Home Environment or Self-Determined - Family, Home & Health project area. Project enrollment requirements are listed under each class.
- All exhibits must be the result of this year's project by the exhibitor.
- Only one exhibit may be entered under each lot number.
- All entries not entered correctly will be judged and placed in the pink ribbon group.

### **REQUIREMENTS:**

- All entries in this department must be handmade and/or created by the exhibitor
- **Posters, scrapbooks and display exhibits:** Exhibitors must follow all requirements located in 'General Rules for Junior Division Exhibitors'
- **Electronic media exhibits:** Exhibitors must follow all requirements located in 'General Rules for Junior Division Exhibitors'

### **CLASS A – HOME ENVIRONMENT**

Open to all exhibitors enrolled in a Home Environment project.

**NOTE:** Holiday or seasonal themed items must be entered in 'Class B: Holiday or Seasonal Items for the Home' if a duplicate lot description is available.

### **Lot Numbers:**

1. Decorative throw pillow, set of (2)
2. Floor pillow or beanbag
3. Pillow cover, set of (2)
4. Centerpiece for a dining table
5. Finish applied to a small wood project
6. Decorative article for the home
7. Refinished or remodeled accessory for the home, include a photo of the item before it was refinished
8. Refinished or remodeled piece of furniture for the home, include a photo of the item before it was refinished
9. Decorative article for the home from artificial materials
10. Decorative article for the home from natural materials
11. Decorative article for the home from a combination of artificial and natural materials
12. Decorative container for a plant
13. Kitchen accessory
14. Coordinating desk set, containing a minimum of (3) items, letter holder, pencil holder, wastebasket, etc.

15. Bulletin board for any room
16. Decorative wall hanging, must be ready to hang, kits accepted
17. Curtains or draperies for any room
18. Fitted slipcover for chair or sofa
19. Dresser scarf
20. Upholstered item
21. Decorative towels for bathroom or kitchen, set of (2)
22. Placemats, set of (4), one to be exhibited with a place setting: 1 glass and 1 plate only
23. Set of two (2) matching potholders or one (1) potholder and (1) mitt set, potholders must be a minimum of 6" diameter
24. Decorative tablecloth with four (4) coordinating napkins
25. Item used for storage made from cloth for any room of the home
26. Area rug or floor cloth
27. Article made from fabric that the exhibitor designed (tie-dyed, batik, photo, crayon, etc.)
28. Tied fleece blanket, no more than three (3) layers of fabric
29. Item for the home made from recycled material. Include a photo of the recycled item(s) before it was used in the project
30. Homemade cleaning or laundry product, list ingredients and recipe on a 3" x 5" index card
31. Poster or display showing a gallery wall of your design (minimum 5 items)
32. Poster or display on alternatives to hazardous cleaning materials used in the home
33. Poster or display on a redecorated or remodeled room. Include before and after photos, fabric and paint samples, etc.
34. Poster or display on a room you re-organized or de-cluttered in your home, include before and after photos, document what organization tools or supplies you used, etc.
35. Scale drawing or display of any room. Include furniture arrangement, samples of material to illustrate combination of fabrics, colors, finishes, etc.
36. Poster or display of a table setting planned around a party or special event, include menu ideas, table decorations, etc.
37. Poster or display of home environment safety rules
38. Any item for the home environment not listed above

## **CLASS B – HOLIDAY OR SEASONAL ITEMS FOR THE HOME**

### **Lot Numbers:**

1. Ornaments, set of (3)
2. Decorative throw pillow, set of (2)
3. Wooden decoration
4. Doorknob trim
5. Wall hanging, must be ready to hang
6. Christmas stocking
7. Crèche
8. Wreath or door sign
9. Tabletop decoration, can include multiple items to create one display
10. Centerpiece for a dining table
11. Placemats, set of (4)
12. Set of two (2) matching potholders or one (1) potholder and (1) mitt set, potholders must be a minimum of 6" diameter
13. Decorative tablecloth or table runner with (4) coordinating napkins
14. Coordinating holiday items used to decorate an area in the home, set of (3)
15. Any other holiday decoration not listed

## **CLASS C - SELF-DETERMINED - HOME ENVIRONMENT**

**Open to all exhibitors enrolled in a Home Environment or Self-Determined - Family, Home & Health project.**

Self-determined project exhibits are records of projects not listed in the premium list or an expansion of a traditional project beyond limits of the project or in greater depth than the project outlines.

**REQUIREMENTS:** Posters, scrapbooks and displays must conform to all requirements listed in 'General Rules for Junior Division Exhibitors'

**Lot Numbers:**

1. A poster promoting your self-determined project
2. An article made during current year with a 3" x 5" index card attached identifying resources. The article should be of reasonable size to exhibit in the Expo building
3. A collection made during current year with a 3" x 5" index card identifying work done
4. A scrapbook with story or essay, drawings, and photos of project work done during the current enrollment year
5. Any other self-determined project not listed above
