ADDITIONAL RULES OF ENTRY

- Youth eligible to exhibit in this department are those enrolled in a 4H, FFA, or other approved youth group carrying a similar supervised program in a Cavies or Pocket Pets project area.
- Only one entry may be entered under each lot number.

REQUIREMENTS:

- All health requirements set by the State of Wisconsin DATCP must be met before the animals are allowed entry at the Fair.
- Any animal displaying symptoms of a contagious disease or parasites will not be allowed to show.
- All pets should be brought to the fair in a suitable cage or container for judging.
- Caged birds and small pets will be brought in at the time of judging and taken home that same day.
- Exhibitors are expected to wear white, long-sleeved shirts, blouses, or show coats and may be graded down if not in proper attire.
- An overall best of show will be selected from all entries in these classes.
- **Tropical Fish:** Tropical fish should not be brought to the fair. Exhibitors should turn in a scrapbook containing a description of the project and photos. Each successive year the exhibitors will update and add to the existing scrapbook. Scrapbooks may be 8 ½ x 11 or 12 x 12 inches in size.
- A complete list of animal exhibit rules can be found in the '**General Rules for Junior Division Exhibitors**' section of the premium book. All rules within that section of the premium book apply, in addition to the information documented herein.

CLASS O – GUINEA PIGS (CAVIES): ALL BREEDS

Lot Number:

1. Boar, any age
2. Sow, any age

CLASS P – CAGED BIRDS

Lot Number:

1. Parakeet (buddies and ring-necked parakeets)
2. Hooked bill (parrot, parrotlets, cockatiel, etc.)
3. Hard bill (finches, canaries, weavers, etc.)
4. Any other caged bird not listed above

CLASS Q – SPECIAL INTEREST SMALL ANIMALS

Lot Number:

1. Small mammals (rodents, ferrets, hedgehogs, etc.)

2. Reptiles and amphibians
3. Tropical fish (See requirements for tropical fish)
4. Goldfish
5. Miscellaneous small pets (invertebrates, other fresh fish, etc.)

CLASS R – SMALL PET SHOWMANSHIP

PREMIUMS: **Ribbon Only**

REQUIREMENTS:

- Exhibitors in small pet showmanship must show one of their project animals in the showmanship class.
- This class will use the Danish Judging system.
